

The following is a step-by-step guide to accessing Facebook Live Worship Services without a facebook account, all live videos are also saved to this same page and available to watch anytime, simply follow the same procedures outlined below:

1. Open Web Browser
(Safari, Chrome, Explorer, Firefox, etc.)

2. Go to this page ([or simply click on this link](https://www.facebook.com/redeemerkenmore)):






